Want to know what the conditions are? Here are some suggestions.

One ... Hike the trail

I did and I can report that the part from the south trail head parking lot to the beginning of the trail is in good shape. The rock climb you get started on looked okay from where I was :)

Two ... call Conservation

204-349-2245 - Westhawk

204-369-3153 - Rennie

They reported that the trail was open and was being used by several hikers. They had not received any bad reports as of 2016/08/21.

Three ... Ask someone who has recently used the trail

Getting There

Highway 44 is a very scenic drive - surface is in good condition and there are some great stops along the way if you come in from the west. I live in Whitemouth so I come in from the west :)

From the west.

Take #44 east from whitemouth for 65.5 KM. Turn left (north) on #312. Follow #312 for 3.0 KM and look for the Trail Head sign on your left. Turn into the parking lot. If you need more help I am available for a modest fee :))

From the east

Take trans-Canada to Westhawk lake. Take 44 west out of Westhawk and drive a short distance to the #312 turnoff. Follow #312 north for 3.0 KM to the Trail head sign on your right.
